Who we are

- The annual Book Sale is one of the largest fundraising events at Fairlawn. Many thousands of dollars are raised over the 3-day Book Sale.

- We meet every Wednesday starting in January of each year between 7:00 & 9:00 pm in the down stairs kitchen (with the exception of Ash Wednesday).

- Saturday, April 28, 2012 ~ 10:00 am to 1:00 pm

What we do

- We sort donations, organized by format and content and price each item.
- On the weekend of the Book Sale, we lay out the donations on tables in the Assembly Hall, & sell books.
- After the Book Sale, we box up any leftover books and make sure they find new homes through the Yonge Street Mission and the St. Vincent de Paul Society.
