Who we are

The coffee hour team sets out coffee, tea, juice and cookies after worship, and provides a warm and welcoming time of connection and fellowship.

What we do

The coffee hour team changes each week. Three or 4 members of the team come in before the service to set-up and start the coffee. We monitor the crowd, collect mugs from those chatting, run the dishes through the dishwasher, and then clean up.

What's in it for you?

Helping with coffee hour makes the event possible, and is an easy way to meet others without a large commitment. Our time at coffee hour is very important to individuals and the congregation as a whole, and would not be possible without the roster of friendly volunteers.

What we need

There are 2 ways to help:

1. You can be one of the two Facilitators. One Facilitator is in charge of personnel and scheduling. The other is in responsible for purchasing (coffee, tea, milk, dish soap)
2. You can volunteer to be on the schedule and help with the occasional coffee hour

Time commitment

- Facilitators are responsible for coffee hour which runs from September until June
- Volunteers usually sign up for 2 Sundays in the fall, and 2 Sundays in the new year
- We are flexible, and we train on the job
- No experience necessary as you would be paired with an experienced volunteer
- Arrive around 9:45 to set up. Attend the 10:30 church service but leave to go to the kitchen before the last hymn. Finish at approximately 12:45
