Who we are

The Worship Council is comprised of a chairperson, the chairperson of the Music Council, the Minister of Worship, and members who represent a cross section of ages, gender, and interests in the congregation. Presently, six of us meet on the first Tuesday of each month at 7.30 pm and we adjourn at 9:00 pm or earlier. We also conduct “e- meetings” and conversations as we see fit. The Primary concern of the Worship Council is the Sanctuary and the services of Worship that are conducted there and anywhere else in the name of Fairlawn United Church.

What we do

We plan, with the Minister(s) of Worship, the Order of Worship, beginning time and the ending time, the special events, sacraments, guest speakers and pulpit supply, and we always look for new opportunities in Worship. It is our job to oversee the Welcomers, the Ushers, the sound and presentation requirements and Music. We also provide guidelines for the care and use of the Sanctuary outside of Worship.

The members of the Worship Council are active and present on Sunday morning – they sing in the choir, usher and welcome worshippers, or they occupy a seat in the pews and converse with new comers at coffee hour. Ideally, we represent the “fabric” of the congregation, and reflect the personality of its members in the act of Worship.
